

How long will a 9kg gas bottle last on a Heatlie BBQ?

A 9kg gas bottle contains 17 litres or approximately 417MJ (megajoules) of energy. The table below lists approximately how long a 9kg gas bottle will last on each of the Heatlie BBQ models. The energy output also relates to how hot the bbq will get, so a comparison with a Weber Q is given to show that the Heatlie BBQ is a much hotter product and is best for commercial catering.

What does this mean for your Heatlie BBQ?

- The flame directly heats the cooking surface, not the air, as in a grill type bbq, providing a quick heat which disperses over the whole of the plate and enables food to cook quickly and evenly.
- Gas usage varies with the size of the barbecue –more gas will be used by larger bbqs
- Gas usage will also depend on outside factors such as the ambient temperature, wind and the amount of food being cooked at one time.
